Pension Declaration for claiming tax relief via Revenue myAccount

If you have made a pension contribution this year which was not a net pay arrangement (i.e., it was not taken as a normal deduction from your salary), then you might claim the tax relief by filing a claim online via Revenue Online Service (ROS).

As part of this process, you may be asked to upload a copy of the pension contribution certificate. For those who are filing by online filing cut-off date, you may not actually have the certificate to upload. Don't worry – you can still complete the process!
