Investment Comment & Outlook

Overall: Central banks will have to finesse the eventual easing off of strong liquidity support against somewhat improving valued against other asset classes. Historically low long-term interest rates could persist in many countries for some time.

Equity Markets

- Equities performed strongly again in July following a 3% pull back the previous month. Markets reacted positively to better economic data (particularly in Europe), share buy-backs in the US and a reasonable Q2 results season. Previous concerns about sharp 'tapering off' of US quantitative easing eased somewhat although tapering is still expected to proceed.
- World equities (in euro terms) rose by close to 3% in July, giving a total return of close to 12% for the first seven months of 2013. The US and Japan have led the rally this year, although most markets were strong during the month.
- Returns, in local currency terms, for the main markets in July ranged from zero % in Japan to close to 7% in the UK.
- Sectorwise, there was little difference between defensives and cyclicals. The main under-performing sector in the US was telecoms which reacted to some weaker earnings' results as well as the sector's bond proxy status.

Bonds & Interest Rates

- The Merrill Lynch Euro over 5 Year Index rose by close to 1% in June, giving a return of almost 1% for the first seven months. All Eurozone markets were in positive territory in July with no meaningful core/peripheral differentiation. Year-todate, however, peripheral markets like Spain (+9%) have sharply outperformed core markets such as Germany (-2%).
- The German 10-year bond yield moved from 1.73% to 1.67%. The 2013 low was around 1.2%. Equivalent US rates moved from 2.5% to 2.6%.
- The ECB, the Fed and the Bank of England all kept rates at record low levels and this policy is unlikely to change anytime soon

Commodities & Currencies

- Commodities rebounded in July, reacting to improved economic data, with the CRB Index rising by 3%.
- Brent oil (European) rose by 5% to \$108 per barrel. West Texas (US) rose by 8% to \$105 per barrel.
- The gold price rebounded sharply (+7%) after heavy falls in previous months, finishing the month at \$1,312 per troy ounce. Gold had reached an all time high of €1,889 in August 2011. Its 2013 high has been just under €1,700.
- The euro was stronger against all of the major currencies on the back of better European economic data. The €/\$ rate moved from 1.30 to 1.33 at month end.

Fund Allocations & Activity

Equities: The funds are slightly overweight.

Bonds: The funds are close to neutral.

Activity: There was an increase in the European equity position.

Regionally, the funds are:

- slightly underweight in the US.
- neutral in the UK, Japan and Pacific Basin.
- slightly overweight in Ireland and Europe.

Sectorwise, the funds are:

- underweight basic materials and energy.
- overweight consumer services.
- otherwise broadly balanced
