

# Zurich Life Monthly Investment Review



For September 2013

## Investment Comment & Outlook

**Overall:** Central banks will have to finesse the eventual tapering off of strong liquidity support against improving economic conditions in order to avoid adverse volatility. Equities appear to have regained their momentum. They remain reasonably valued against other asset classes.

### **Equity Markets**

- Equities pushed ahead again during September, following the bumpy pattern seen over the summer. Markets reacted positively to stronger leading economic indicators, especially in Europe. This in turn has led to strong flows into equities primarily in Europe (on valuation grounds) and Japan (on the back of the reform plans).
- World equities (in euro terms) rose by 2.5% in September, giving a total return of just under 13% for the first nine months of 2013. Apart from Ireland and the UK, all markets were strong during the month. The US and Japan have led the rally so far this year, but these markets are now being joined by Europe.
- Sectorwise, cyclical stocks (such as industrials and basic materials) clearly out-performed defensives, especially in the US. The defensive consumer staples sector has become quite expensive on a P/E valuation basis.

#### **Bonds & Interest Rates**

- The Merrill Lynch Euro over 5 Year Index rose by close to 1% in September, giving a return of almost one percent for the first nine months. All Eurozone markets performed roughly in-line. Year-to-date, peripheral markets like Spain (+12%) have sharply outperformed core markets such as Germany (-3%).
- The German 10-year bond yield moved from 1.86% to 1.78%. The 2013 low was around 1.2%. Equivalent US rates moved from 2.8% to 2.6%.
- The ECB, the Fed and the Bank of England all kept interest rates at record low levels but rates in the US and the UK are now expected to start rising in about 12 months time and at least 18 months time in the Eurozone.

#### **Commodities & Currencies**

- Commodities retreated somewhat during the month as pressure came off energy prices. The CRB Index fell by 2%.
- Brent oil (European) fell by 5% to \$108 per barrel, West Texas (US) also fell by 5% to \$102 per barrel.
- The gold price lost its gains of the previous month falling by 5% to \$1,326 per troy ounce. Gold had reached an all time high of €1,889 in August 2011. Its 2013 high has been just under €1,700.
- The euro was mixed against a number of major currencies; stronger against the US\$ and the Japanese yen, weaker against sterling and the Aussie dollar. The €/\$ rate moved from 1.32 to 1.35 at month end.

#### **Fund Allocations & Activity**

**Equities:** The funds are slightly overweight.

**Bonds:** The funds are underweight.

**Activity:** There was an slight increase in financial stocks.

#### Regionally, the funds are:

- Underweight in the UK.
- Neutral in the US, Japan and Pacific Basin.
- Overweight in Ireland and Europe.

#### Sectorwise, the funds are:


- underweight utilities and energy.
- overweight consumer services.
- otherwise broadly balanced.

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
